- ✓ Talk with key adults at your school or club to get permission to introduce the Eco-Hero Launchpad at your school site.
- ✓ Fundraise for environmental causes using the Eco-Hero Launchpad with the goal to inspire 4 or more classrooms to join you.
- ✓ Facilitate the use of the Eco-Hero Launchpad by visiting classrooms or communicating with classroom teachers.
- ✓ Be sure to share your unique Ambassador code with participating classrooms, so we can provide you with analytics on your success.

Perks

- ✓ You'll have the opportunity to add new 501(c)3 environmental nonprofit organizations to the Eco-Hero Launchpad from your area.
- ✓ When you add non-profits to the Launchpad, you will gain valuable communication & research skills as you interface with the organizations to gather information about them.
- ✓ Earn a We Save the World T-Shirt.
- ✓ When you complete your volunteer hours (about 10) we provide you with the analytics of how many students participated because of you and how much money you raised together. These statistics will help you stand out on college and job applications.
